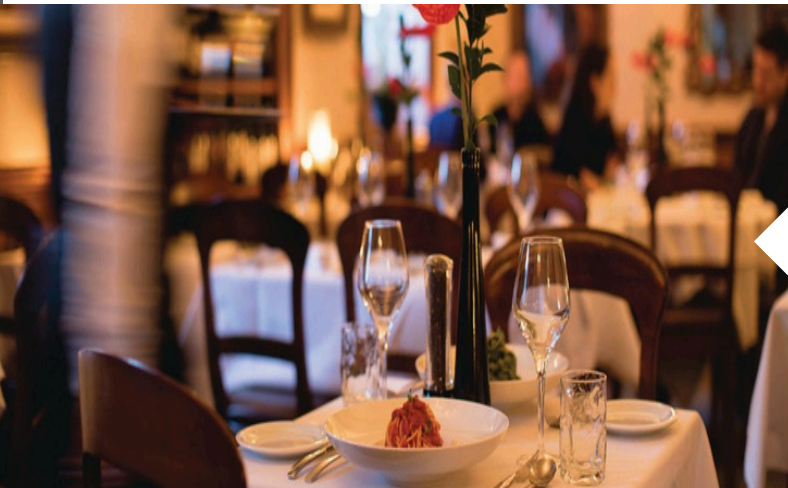


Ballykeefe Distillery
